

CITY OF HUMBLE | NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING PROPOSED BUDGET – FISCAL YEAR 2020-21

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Humble, Texas will hold a Public Hearing on September 10, 2020 at 6:30 P.M. in the City Hall Council Chamber, located at 114 West Higgins, Humble, Texas, 77338.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to consider the City's Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 and to allow members of the public to attend and participate in the meeting. In accordance with an Order of the Office of the Governor issued March 16, 2020 and in order to advance the public health goal of limiting face-to-face meetings (also called "social distancing") to slow the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19), seating will be limited to 50% Fire Code capacity or 24 people. Overflow into the hallway is allowed but there will not be video or audio enhancement in this area. The Public Hearing will not be available via telephone or videoconferencing. Citizens who wish to attend the Public Hearing in person must abide by the following requirements:

- Do not enter the building if you are having symptoms. Go home.
- Maintain a minimum distance of 6 feet from other citizens.
- Families or persons traveling together may sit together, but maintain social distancing from others.
- Face coverings are encouraged, but not mandatory.

This budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by \$664,248 | 13.06%, and of that amount \$179,909 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year.
