Mayor Aaron called the emergency meeting of the Humble City Council to order with a quorum present at 1:00 P.M.

1. INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

Council Member Funderburk offered the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. ORDINANCE 17-808 EXTENDING THE DISASTER DECLARATION ISSUED BY MAYORAL PROCLAMATION ON AUGUST 27, 2017 IN RESPONSE TO HURRICANE HARVEY.

Mayor Aaron invited Fire Marshal Nykaza to discuss the declaration extension. Mr. Nykaza stated that continuing the Declaration of Disaster permits the city to continue to receive Federal, State and

County assistance in response to Hurricane Harvey. Mr. Nykaza noted that many cities in Harris County had declared their disasters for 30 days – though at this time staff was asking only for a continuance through the next regular Council Meeting on September 14th. Mr. Nykaza also said that the declaration will help with emergency purchases to get city facilities back up and running or if a secondary disaster effects the city.

Mayor Aaron noted that he had spoken with other mayors and that they all extended their declarations to ensure that FEMA activities were expedited.


Upon a motion by Mayor Pro Tem Steagall, the City Council voted six (6) for and none (0) opposed to adopt Ordinance 17-808 extending the Declaration of Disaster within the City of Humble in response to Hurricane Harvey.
